
# Submitting Documents for Academic Initial Eligibility

### **United Kingdom**

#### **PURPOSE**

To participate at an NCAA Division I or II school, you must be certified as academically eligible by working with your secondary school to have them submit your academic documents to the Eligibility Center. This resource is designed to help you understand how and when to submit specific documents (e.g., General Certificate of Secondary Education exam results) that will give you a faster and more accurate academic decision. *Questions about this resource?* Email the Eligibility Center at ec-international@ncaa.org or use the International Contact Form.



#### **NEXT STEPS**

**Note:** You are not permitted to send any academic records to the Eligibility Center. Ensure your secondary school has your <u>board-issued</u> exam results or certificates.

- 1. Download the United Kingdom Academic Record Submission Checklist and email the checklist to your secondary school.
- 2. Ensure your secondary school has your <u>board-issued</u> exam certificates or results. *Note:* Only your secondary school can submit these academic records to the Eligibility Center.
- In addition to the GCSE exams, if you have taken or are in the process of taking any other exams or attempting to earn any other certificates, reference the Graduation Timeline Confirmation Form.

*Examples:* A-Levels, AS Exams, BTEC, GCE O-Level, OCR Level 1 or 2, WJEC Level 1/2.


